OPerA Studio Architecture (www.opera-studio.com) is seeking architectural interns to assist in a research project. We are preparing a presentation and exhibit exploring design and planning strategies for recently up-zoned Brooklyn neighborhoods. Several areas of the city are slated for huge growth, and recent city planning guidelines fall short of creating guidelines that will create new neighborhoods with a distinct character.

Further, we see these large scale reconstructions of large parts of the city as opportunities to explore the potential of evolved building typologies and configurations. The zoning guidelines alone don't allow for this, and it is our goal to proactively explore how more developed strategies can be applied across multiple sites.

A second goal of the research project is to look at how these strategies can be rolled out and implemented: how can communities and city agencies work to implement guidelines to create better new neighborhoods.

The internship will be unpaid with a monthly stipend for expenses. The time frame is flexible: we're looking for interns for any period of time between Fall 2016 and March of 2017, when the project will be presented at a conference at the New York Build expo at the Jacob Javitz center.

The minimum time commitment would be three weeks. We are located in Brooklyn, NY.
