* All incoming students for the fall of 2020 are eligible to take equivalency exams for ARC 611/612, ARC 631/639, and ARC 621. Those who demonstrate proficiency in these subjects through these exams will receive credit for these courses towards their degree requirements.

** All students currently enrolled in the English for Architecture program, as well as those who are recommended to based on the results of the English Language Assessment Exam, enroll in ARC 651 (Language and Discourse in Architecture) in place of ARC 641 in the Fall 2020 and enroll in ARC 641 in Fall 2021. These students take one fewer Professional Elective course.
