Strongly recommended courses:

*ARC 133 – Introduction to the History of Architecture I (spring)
Themes, concepts, and problems in architectural history from ancient Egypt to 1500.

Additional course recommendations that may aid in portfolio creation:

*ARC 101 – The Art of Architecture for Non-Majors (spring)
Architectural concepts and form-generating principles. Lectures present historical and contemporary examples.

*ARC 391 – Architectural Drawing for Non-Majors (fall)
Skills and visual principles for an architect; freehand drawing and drafting. Production of a sketchbook and portfolio material suitable for application to professional programs.

*ARC 394 – Architectural Design for Non-Majors (spring)
The determination of architectural form and the process of design. For students outside the School of Architecture professional degree program. Prereq: ARC 391

ARI 231 – Drawing I Observation

The focus of this course is to learn to see and allow the experience to develop into drawing.

ARI 232 – Drawing through the Figure

The objectives of this drawing course are to perceive and understand the human figure in terms of proportion, structure, motion, surface and volumes. Prereq: ARI 231

ARI 261 – Painting Studio I

Figurative and nonfigurative painting in oils or acrylics as the basis for study of color and form. Materials and approaches.
