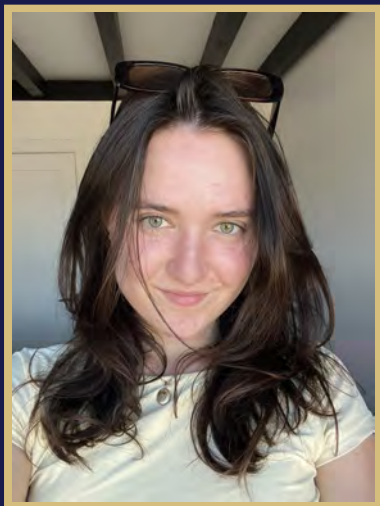
On campus I am involved with UIOO student tour guides, Architecture Ambassadors, the American Institute of Architecture Students, and I also participate in a few different intramural sports.

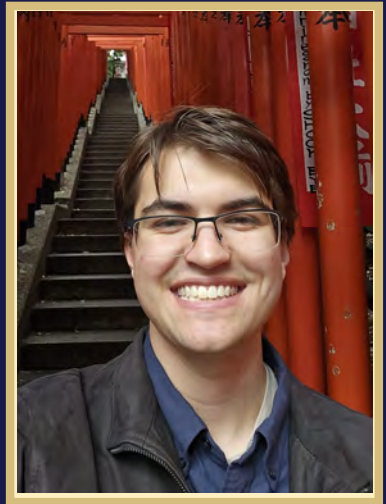
# ADAM WINGERT

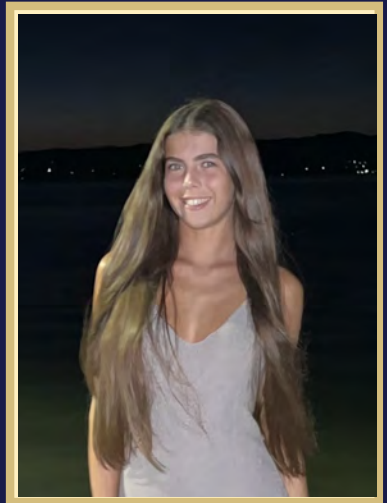
# ZSOFI VERES
